

Central Oklahoma Cactus and Succulent Society

The Central Oklahoma Cactus and Succulent Society (COCSS) was founded in Oklahoma City in 1968 as one of more than 100 affiliates of the Cactus and Succulent Society of America (CSSA), which was organized in 1929 to promote better understanding and appreciation of some of nature's most unusual and unique creations. The CSSA is dedicated to the conservation and preservation of threatened and endangered plant life throughout the world.

Society's Purpose

1. To learn about cacti and other succulent plants.
2. To disseminate knowledge and promote interest.
3. To educate the public about the need to preserve these plants in their native habitat.

Membership Eligibility

The COCSS has members from all over Oklahoma, mostly in the Oklahoma City area. Any person may become a member by paying membership dues.

Meeting Time and Place

The COCSS meets monthly throughout the year on the 3rd Thursday of the month. Meetings are held at 7:00 p.m. at the Will Rogers Garden Exhibition Building, 3400 NW 36th St, OKC, OK.

Programs

The club hosts formal talks and demonstrations about horticulture and botany of cacti and other succulent plants and we sponsor guest speakers, including well-known experts on cacti and succulents. We present slide shows and videotapes, many done by members who have traveled to places such as Mexico, Africa and South America. Among our other activities, we enjoy field trips to greenhouses and natural habitats. Several members regularly attend regional and national shows and conventions across the United States. We have a well-stocked library of books and publications available for checkout by members in good standing.

Annual Show & Sale

The COCSS holds it's Annual Show and Sale at the Will Rogers Garden Center, 3400 NW 36th St, Oklahoma City, OK, which is open to the public with free admission. The Show and Sale consists of a judged plant show, educational displays, and a large sales area drawing in vendors from across OK and surrounding states that bring a large selection of cacti and succulent plants.
